Composition projekt	The aim is to lay the foundations for innovative, dynamic and active international cooperation in artistic and cultural life. Develop an individual application for participation in a glass art competition, creative tour, seminar, etc. To apply for a project for financial support – VKKF, Nordens (Nordic Latvia), etc. Developing a full-fledged new artist, Port Folio. To get experience in the implementation of transnational and local projects. Understand networking between cultural and artistic organisations, professional artists and other creative professionals.
